## CLASSES FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The Museum of East Texas will offer classes for high school students **June 1-5, 2009 from 1:00 to 4:00 pm.** Class registration costs include art supplies! Classes are dependent on minimum enrollment.

### **Ceramics** with Laura Hudgins

This course will provide students with a foundation in basic pottery techniques as well as additive and subtractive sculptural processes. Appropriate for introductory and intermediate level students; returning students will be allowed to work at their own pace, building on previously acquired skills.

### **Acrylic Painting** with Ann Reyes

This course will present the basic techniques used in acrylic painting and introduce students to the "daily painting" concept where a small original painting will be created each day. A variety of subjects will be used for these exciting projects.

### **Printmaking** with Lisa Haglund

Students in this class will create mono-prints with a focus on visual texture. The prints will use natural and man-made objects as the creative anchor for works that will be developed using multi-media layers.

### **Photography** with Scott Strickland

High school students will gain an understanding of advanced concepts in photography, involving technical as well as conceptual techniques in photography. Students will be introduced to the concepts of F-stops, reciprocity, and design, as well as studio photography, commercial photography, and the importance of the photograph as a work of art.

### **Mixed Media** with Denise Davis

Artists will combine 3D and 2D elements to create works of art. These works will be used to explore installation art and how artists invent spaces for the viewer to experience.

### **Cardmaking** with Amanda Lasiter

Students will use paint, crayons, pen, pencil, construction paper, photography, and more to create miniature works of art about the same size as playing cards. The students will produce many of these cards and will be given the option of exchanging some of their cards.
