REGISTRATION POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

To enroll in Art Camp, each participant must fill out and turn in all color forms:

- D. Media Release/Exhibition Form (pg. 8)

Notes:

- Registration is *NOT* accepted over the phone or online. Payment must be received to hold a spot in the session. Register early as spots fill quickly!
- To keep fees low, each Art Camp participant will only receive one t-shirt, regardless of number of sessions enrolled.
- Although there is no registration deadline for Art Camp, all expenses are paid from registration fees. Therefore, **NO REFUNDS** will be given except for classes that are cancelled by the Museum.
- Museum members are eligible for a tuition discount for their children and grandchildren. To receive this discount, write the name of the qualifying member on their registration form in the members section (pg. 3).
- Scholarships are available through the generosity of the Museum Guild from funds raised through their annual Festival of Trees and private donations; please contact the Curator of Education for more information.
- We regret that awarded scholarships will be forfeited if recipients do not attend the first day of their scheduled session(s).

SESSION INFORMATION

A complete session of Art Camp meets half a day (9:00 am – 12:00 pm or 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm) Monday – Friday weeks 2-5 and 7-11. Sessions are labeled by week number and date. Wee Art meets 9:30 am – 11:00 am weeks 1 and 12, and adult classes meet 9:00 am – 12:00pm or 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm weeks 1, 6, and 12.

The risk of injuries is a risk that the students and/or their legal guardian voluntarily agree to assume in exchange for the privilege of participating in the Museum of East Texas Art Camp. The students and/or their legal guardian understand and agree that this risk is not a risk that the Museum of East Texas assumes and that the Museum of East Texas is not responsible for any injuries to the students. Accordingly, the student and their legal guardian voluntarily release, discharge, and waive the right to sue the Museum of East Texas and its directors, trustees, officers, employees, volunteers, agents and all persons acting by, through, under, or in concert with the Museum of East Texas for any and all losses, demands, claims, suits, causes of action, liability, costs, expenses, and judgments whether arising in equity, at common law, or by statute, under the

law of contracts, torts, or property, for personal injury (including without limitation emotional distress), arising in favor of the guardian, the student, or anyone claiming through us based upon, in connection with, relating to or arising out of, directly or indirectly, the student's participation in Museum of East Texas Art Camp **EVEN IF ANY SUCH CLAIMS ARE DUE TO THE RELEASED PARTIES' OWN NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY WITHOUT REGARD TO FAULT, VIOLATION OF STATUTE, OR OTHER FAULT, INCLUDING ANY NEGLIGENT ACT, OMISSION, OR INTENTIONAL ACT INTENDED TO PROMOTE MY CHILD'S SAFETY OR WELL-BEING.** The student and/or legal guardian hereby grants permission to the Museum of East Texas to obtain emergency medical treatment for the student if the Museum of East Texas deems in its discretion that such emergency medical treatment is necessary.

Frequently Asked Questions

What should my child wear to art class?

Wear comfortable clothes that can get messy.

What are the behavior expectations?

Students are expected to listen, follow instructions, participate in class activities, respect others, respect property, and have fun!

Does Museum of East Texas Art Camp provide before class or after class supervision?

Children may be dropped off no earlier than 30 minutes before their scheduled class time and must be picked up promptly after class. Children may also eat lunch at Art Camp between the morning and afternoon sessions (lunch not provided).

May I stay in the classroom with my child?

This will be addressed as needed on an individual basis.

May I register a gifted child for an older age group?

No. Age requirements are strictly enforced and are not negotiable. All children must be registered in their correct age groups.

A friend/relative is visiting from out of town. May he/she attend class as a guest with my child?

This will be addressed on an individual basis due to class enrollment.
