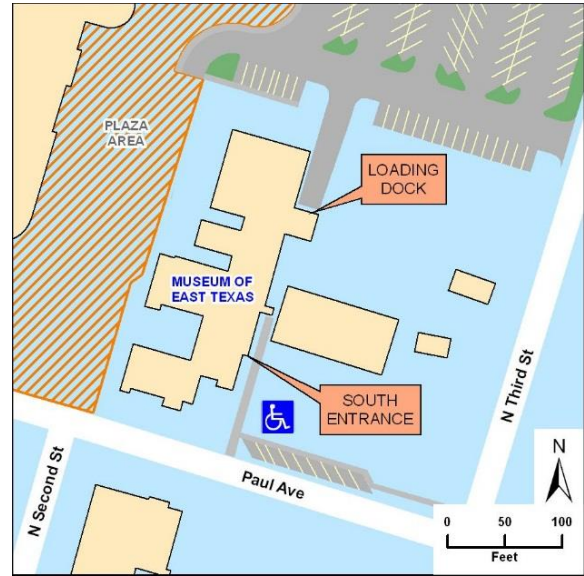

Art Campers with mobility issues may enter and exit using the front doors on the Plaza or the south entrance on Paul Ave. Parking is provided in the north parking lot and on Paul Ave. Please see map.
